

**Title: Buffalo Management Unit Field Technician**

**General Description:**

Carry out directives set forth by the Unit Manager, Oglala Sioux Parks and Recreation Authority in maintaining healthy, viable populations of elk and bison within Oglala Sioux Game Ranges in accordance with principles of sound wildlife management. Responsibilities include all aspects of facility maintenance, protection and management.

**Duties:**

- Comprehensive maintenance and protection of Allen and Slim Butte bison and elk management units to include both wildlife and facility management.
- Participate in wildlife trapping, culling and restocking operations.
- Gather inventory data relevant to wildlife and range conditions and recommend appropriate remedial action when such action is called for.
- Provide supplemental feeding of game range animals during periods when natural forage is unavailable.
- Slaughter, proper field care, and transportation of bison according to allocation demands.
- Provide full range of services to hunting clients to include guiding services, lodging accommodations, transportation, food services, trophy care and meat processing.
- Maintain daily activity log and submit monthly reports  
Perform other duties as assigned by Unit Manager.

**Qualifications:**

- Must have a practical knowledge of wildlife, hunting techniques, and field handling of trophies.
- Possess leadership qualities and be acquainted with local residents, local conditions, systems, and have established an interest in community and district affairs.
